This charity fundraiser will take place at Council Rock South High School in Holland, PA. We are happy to announce that the charity for this year's event will be **"PINS FOR KIDS"**.

"PINS FOR KIDS" was started at Saint Mark's High School in Wilmington, Delaware by wrestling team member Zachary Frederick during the 2005-2006 wrestling season. The original purpose was to raise money to help children with diseases. It did not take long to realize that Tay - Sachs disease was the one that would get the wrestling team's attention. Both the St. Mark's Administration and then Head Coach Jason Bastianelli were quick to support the program along with everything it stood for. After Zach's graduation, Coach Bastianelli and other team members have continued the program. Several other Delaware high school teams have also joined the effort. Our inaugural "Wrestle 4 Relief" event took place in October of 2005 with the proceeds going to the Red Cross in support of the Hurricane Katrina relief effort. Other charities that have benefited from Wrestle 4 Relief events are Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation, NeighborHeart Program, the D'Angelo Foundation and the Beat the Streets Wrestling Program of Philadelphia. In all, the "Wrestle 4 Relief" tournaments have raised nearly \$19,000 for these charities. YOU are making a difference. "I know that this may sound like a cliché, but this wrestling community is indeed a family! This community transcends sports and competition.
